The U.S. Institute of Peace is constructing a headquarters building at the northwest corner of the National Mall in Washington, D.C. The new building will be a working headquarters for the Institute and a national center for advancing the study and practice of peacebuilding.

Cleveland Construction is currently providing drywall and metal framing, acoustical and specialty custom ceiling, veneer plaster, acoustical insulation and miscellaneous installations.

The project is expected to be completed in June 2010.
